



GATEWAY MONUMENTS

The signage used to identify an area creates an instant impression of the place itself. Five custom designed gateway monuments have been constructed in the Town Center CID. The monuments are located at key entry points into the district and help to signify the area. The first location of two monuments is at the northbound and southbound exit ramps from I-75 to Barrett Parkway. The second location is two monuments at the northbound and southbound exit ramps from I-575 to Barrett Parkway. The final location is at the intersection of US 41/Cobb Parkway and Barrett Parkway. These monuments were created out of fieldstone and granite and are 20 feet tall.

The monuments display the Town Center CID logo, which is an interpretation of a map location symbol, and the Town Center name to assist travelers in identifying that they have entered the CID. Landscape enhancements have occurred surrounding the monuments for a finishing touch.

Additional monuments on the northern side of the district are being considered for future installation.
