

Skip Spann Connector



Project Overview

The Skip Spann Connector created a four-lane road and 10-foot multi-use path over I-75, realigning Townpark Lane into a roundabout at Busbee Drive. Its most striking feature is the lighted bridge design that reflects the iconic shape of Kennesaw Mountain.

- Access point to the Noonday Creek Trail
- > 50-space parking lot
- Restroom facility with drinking fountain
- Bikeshare station

What's Next?

Included in the 2016 SPLOST projects, Cobb County Department of Transportation added an eight-footwide sidewalk on the west side of Bells Ferry Road beginning at the trailhead and extending north toward Big Shanty Road.
