



Frequently Asked Questions

What time does each race start?

7:45 am: 10K start | 8:00 am: 5K start

Where can I park?

Both races start and end on the north side of Town Center at Cobb Mall, and there is plenty of free on-site parking.

Can I register on race day?

Yes, but allow some extra time to get through registration. We recommend arriving at least 30 minutes before your race starts. T-shirts are not guaranteed for race-day registrants.

What time do I arrive on race day?

If you get your race packet early at packet pick-up, you can arrive 15 minutes before your race starts. If you register on race day, plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before your race starts.

Can I pick up someone else's number and t-shirt?

Yes.

Are teams allowed?

Yes. The team captain must create the team by selecting "Create a Team" on the registration site. Once created, each team member will click on "Join a Team" when they register individually. Please note, everyone on a team must run the same distance so if you have runners interested in both distances you will need to create a 5k team and a 10k team.

How many runners do you need to make a team?

To qualify for awards, teams must consist of 5 or more runners.

If I'm on a team, can I pick up my own race packet?

Yes, but please check with your team captain first to make sure your team captain has not arranged to pick up the packets for the entire team.

What is the policy on refunds of registration fees?

No refunds are issued for registration fees.

If I'm a virtual runner, can I pick up my t-shirt after the race?

Virtual runners are encouraged to pick up their shirts at packet pick-up the Thursday before race day. Email brandy@towncentercid.com to make special arrangements to pick up t-shirts the week after the race.

Can I transfer my registration to someone else if I can't attend?

Yes, transfers are available on the registration site.

Will the race be canceled if the weather is bad?

This is a "rain-or-shine" event. However, in the event of severe weather with lightning on race morning, the race may be delayed. Any weather-related changes will be posted on the registration site and our website: towncentercid.com/noonday-shanty.

Are strollers allowed in the race?

Yes. For safety reasons, participants with strollers will be asked to line up behind the other runners and are encouraged to register for the 5K distance.

Are dogs allowed?

Yes. For safety reasons, runners with dogs must line up behind the other runners and dogs must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet.

Are there any special provisions for wheelchair participants?

This event includes a "push assist" wheelchair bracket. The courses include conditions that may not be ideal for wheelchairs without push assist.

Are there water stations along the course?

One water station serving both the 5K and 10K courses is located on Chastain Meadows Parkway. Water also is provided in the post-race area.

Are there restrooms along the course?

Restrooms are available at the start/finish area, but there are no designated restrooms along the courses.

Is there medical support available during the race?

Yes, medical support will be stationed at the start/finish area and accessible along the course if needed.

Can I walk the race instead of running?

Absolutely! Walkers are encouraged to register for the 5K distance.

What are the awards and is there a ceremony?

An award ceremony will be held after the race around 9:00am. The top runners in each bracket and the top team will be given awards. Award brackets include:

- Overall male/female
- Masters male/female
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd place male and female in their age groups

Where and when can I check my results?

Check www.s2events.com/results immediately following the race for results.

Are awards based on chip-start or gun-start times?

Awards are based on chip-start times.

How will I know if I am a top runner eligible for awards?

You will receive a text and email when you cross the finish line that will show if you are eligible.

Where do the race proceeds go?

All race proceeds go to the Town Center Community Alliance, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, and will be used for future greenspace and trail projects in the Town Center area.
